At PHOTOSHOOT Magazine, we take how we use and hold your personal data very seriously.

The information below explains how we operate good practice.

We hold only limited amounts of personal data necessary for the job in hand so as to provide you with the services which you use or have purchased from us. These include:

- Email and communication
- Submissions using your provided media, data and contact details
- Purchases through our online shop

We do not hold or use your personal data for any other purpose, unless we have asked for, and obtained, your consent.

In order to provide our services, including facilitating magazine issues, we need to hold a limited amount of personal data about you and your team (if applicable). This usually includes first names, last names, email addresses, telephone numbers (where relevant) and social media links.

We hold this information for as long as we have contact with you or until we no longer need to use your personal data or until you tell us not to.

Only authorised PHOTOSHOOT Magazine personnel have access to your data. We do not sell or make available any of your personal data to third parties for marketing purposes or for any other reason.

Webserver: PHOTOSHOOT Magazine's web-platform is hosted by Siteground and based in London, who comply with GDPR.

Company Email: Our email system is hosted by Siteground.

Mailing System: Our website subscription data collection is integrated with MailChimp, who comply with GDPR.

Backup System: We use an external backup disk to store past magazine issues, which is password protected. Past magazine issues are in the public domain.

Local Storage: We also hold copies of the data required to run our organisation on our local computer systems. Our computer systems are password protected.
